Here is how you do it:

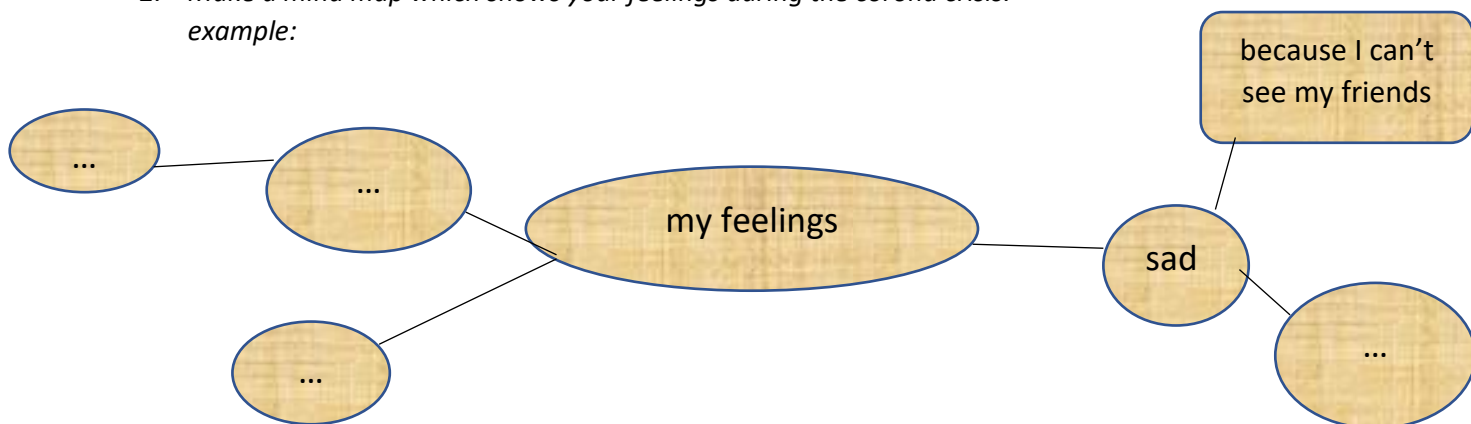
1. *Make a list of things you normally do during a day since school stopped (use the list of useful words and phrases).*
